

PROTEIN SOURCES MILLING 2008 FALL GRAIN PROGRAM

Intent at delivery of grain: Please let the scale operator know of your intent for the grain delivered when it is unloaded. It must be marked as Contracted, Sold, Price Later, or Grain Bank. The oldest contract for that delivery time will be filled first. **THERE WILL BE NO WAREHOUSE OR CCC LOANS BEING PROCESSED OR ISSUED!**

Spot Selling: When done on multiple loads the price will be determined at that day's closing price until 5:00 PM, there after the loads will be priced at the following day's close, unless pricing is specified by grower.

We will not issue a check until a request is made. Please allow one business day for check and give notice to us for any deferred payment arrangements.

Moisture allowance: (Corn assigned to Price Later, Grain Bank, Contracted, or Sold Bushels) Moisture is factored at 15 %. ***You will be assessed a drying charge and shrink if moisture is higher than 15%.*** Drying fees will be \$.06 cents per point of moisture. Shrink factor will be 1.4% for each point of moisture removed. We will invoice you for the drying service or remove balance due from grain check. Loads of corn delivered to the feed mill in Mapleton must be at 15% maximum moisture or it will be rejected.

Quality control: There is zero tolerance for damage on corn delivered to our sites. ***ON-FARM PICKUP IS A SERVICE WE OFFER FOR NOT ONLY DAMAGED CORN BUT ALSO FOR OTHER GRAIN DESTINATIONS. WE WANT TO SERVICE ALL OF YOUR GRAIN DELIVERY NEEDS!*** Call for quotes.

Grain Bank: Corn will be charged a \$.02 cents/bushel/month service fee from October '08 to March '09. No fee there after. If not used for feed rations then charges will be calculated as Price Later.

Bean Delivery: Accepted only at Good Thunder and must be 13% moisture or less. We will assess shrink of 2% per 1% of moisture. We will average the moisture at 14% and below. Beans above 14% will stand-alone and the moisture shrink will be discounted separately.

Price Later Fees: Grain put on Price Later Contracts will be charged \$.04 cents/month/bushel cost with a minimum fee of .12 cents per bushel. **This charge is subject to change after our space is full. We will then charge the prevailing commercial industry rate!**
